



3DPAZ Contest Rules

Entry Process

Before you start designing, you must first fill out the registration form on our website. Once you register and finish your design, you must submit: an STL file of your design and a 3-5 minute video of you or your team presenting your design. Your video should include:

- Brief introduction of individual/team
- The product you decided to improve/redesign
- Why you decided to improve this product
- Why and how your design improves the existing solution
- Show your design as well

The way you present your design is important. Make sure everyone on your team is on the same page. Practice, review, be comfortable, and have fun!

Judging Entries

Your design should be creative, realistic, beautiful, and achievable. Judges will be looking for:

- Design creativity
- How realistic and achievable it is
- The improvements you made
- How well your performance was on the video
- Sound mechanical design

Deadline

The 2014 3DPAZ deadline is October 6th, 2014. That is the date you must submit everything by and when the contest closes. We will be selecting finalist and winners on October 15th, 2014.

Judges

A panel of PADT workers will be your judges. They are all qualified to make the decisions of finalist and winners.

Official 3DPAZ Rules

- Each school is limited to 3 entries in the 3DPAZ contest.
- A person can work individually or in teams
- Each team/individual must submit the registration form and media release before they begin drawing.
- Entries must include an STL file of their design as well as a 3-5 minute video of their design. Details of video is explained above.
- The size of the design must be no larger than 10x10x10 inches. If your design is larger than this, please scale down the STL file before submitting.
- If your model needs to be assembled, please save assemblies as individual STL files. Also instruct us how to assemble it.
- If your entry could be used as a weapon, or is a replica of a weapon, you will be considered ineligible for the contest.
- All 3DPAZ entries (videos, images, descriptions, and designs) submitted to PADT can be used by PADT for promotional purposes.
